HUD Sales Price is \$269,000 or less


- Buydown of the Market Appraised Value (\$310K to \$320K)





Provide effective and efficient public safety services that remains pro-active and allows for enhanced community relations and preparedness.

Initiatives

- Implement pro-active, community-based solutions to build strong community relations.
- Proactively and consistently respond to shifting crime trends and emerging social problems.
- Attract and retain a skilled community-oriented and diverse sworn and civilian workforce.
- Ensure training and readiness of Public Safety employees.
- Enhance community disaster preparedness initiatives.
- Enhance community standard efforts while continuing to strive for voluntary compliance.

Performance Indicators

- Monitor Florida Department of Law Enforcement Habitual Criminal and Sex Offenders Registration & increase community awareness.
- Develop a network within neighborhoods to enhance communication between members of the police department and the community.
- Continue to find new ways to communicate and reach the entire community with the latest news and information.
- · Institute an "If you see it, report it" program.
- Establish a Quarterly "Faith Based Alliance" Meeting.
- Enhance the community participation in crime reduction efforts
- Encourage the youth of the community to use police officers as a resource rather than an adversary.
- Attend and present up-to-date statistical information at public meetings.
- Engage citizens in the public safety service-delivery process

Provide effective and efficient public safety services that remains pro-active and allows for enhanced community relations and preparedness.

Performance Indicators

- Create and monitor a monthly repeat crime location.
- Provide increased presence in crime "hot spots" to reduce criminal activity.
- Deploy police personnel and resources in a manner to more effectively prevent and respond to crime in Cocoa.
- Ensure Cocoa citizens returning to the community from incarceration are provided support information on community resource partners
- Provide support for the local educational system in Cocoa (increase the educational attainment of Cocoa citizens).
- Incorporate data-based decision-making in determining effective and efficient delivery of services.
- Incorporate advances in technology related to effective and efficient delivery of public safety services.

Performance Indicators

- Response Time of 320 seconds or less.
- Monitor the top incident types and develop an action plan for each type.
- Ensure training and equipment are sufficient to meet service demands.
- Coordinate with Code Enforcement to gain compliance with chronically nuisance properties.
- Improve the City's physical image through the appearance of privately owned properties within Cocoa through improved maintenance, code enhancements and incentives.
- Improve the City's image through removal of unsightly graffiti and waste accumulation.



INVESTMENT IN PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE

Ensure safe and efficient public infrastructure that drives growth and development in an environmentally responsible manner.

Initiatives

- Ensure the delivery of safe, clean drinking water to all utility customers.
- Enhance the City's transportation networks. (Train, Bicycle, Walk, Drive, Public Transit, Multi-modal Brightline Station)
- Invest in environmental stewardship.
- Support a safe, accessible, well-maintained network of parks, facilities and greenspace.
- Continually invest in parking solutions for Cocoa Village.

- Improve the city's image through aesthetic improvement of its physical infrastructure, including streets, public buildings, public areas and parks.
- Hydrant Maintenance, Duel Check Backflow Change-Out, Old Age Meter Change-Out, Radio Read Route Conversion, Valves Maintenance

- Post a monthly update in the weekly edition of the Florida Today newspaper.

Performance Indicators

- Host an annual Citizens Academy program to teach residents and business owners about the City of Cocoa and how it operates and how they can get involved, creating a more educated and engaged volunteer.
- Maintain a branding kit with standards and a use policy application for the community.
- Expand the City's branding efforts beyond existing city buildings and downtown areas.
- Host 6 City sponsored special events throughout the year to reach our diverse community.

- Enhance efforts to attract, develop and support a qualified and capable workforce reflective of the community.

- Administer monthly new hire orientation training.
- Systematically evaluate service delivery methods.
- Implement a performance measurement system across the City organization.
- Maintain and control the expenditure levels, and reduce them when appropriate, while not substantially affecting the levels of services.
- Diversify and enhance the revenue base available to fund city operations.
