

Due to the closure of Lee Wenner Park, we have adjusted the event as follows:

- There is only the full and half marathon races (no longer a “north” and “south” half option).
 - The half marathon will only feature the “south” course”
- The start and finish for both races will be at the same point, on Harrison St in front of Village Idiot Pub, however there will still be 2 separate starts (full at 6am, half at 6:15am)
 - RZ staff will need Harrison St. cleared immediately at the close of business (2am or earlier) on Sunday morning and any remaining cars removed.
- The start of both races will be different than years past and new road closures will be needed.
 - Full marathon participants will start on Harrison St. and make immediate RIGHT onto Delannoy Ave and cross King St/Willard St., turn LEFT on Willard St. in the northernmost westbound lane. They will turn RIGHT onto Indian River Dr. and head north to the turnaround point (exact location TBD, but approximately at Fairview Ave- north of the previous turnaround point; not Cocoa jurisdiction but included for reference)
 - Half marathon participants will start on Harrison St. and make immediate LEFT onto Delannoy Ave, followed by a RIGHT turn on Church St, LEFT turn on Brevard Ave., and LEFT turn on Derby St. to reach Rockledge Dr.
- The full marathon route to cross 520 later in the race and join the “south” course on Rockledge Dr. will be similar but adjusted as follows:
 - From Florida Ave., participants turn LEFT on Factory St, RIGHT on Brevard Ave, and LEFT on Derby St to reach Rockledge Dr.
 - Full marathon participants that can not finish the course and elect to stop “halfway” will have signage and RZ staff at a designated point on Florida Ave to facilitate the switch (likely Orange St.)
 - Full marathon participants that fall behind the cutoff time will end at this point as well
- The finish of both races will be different than years past but not change the road closures
 - All participants will head north on Rockledge Dr to Church St., turn RIGHT to follow the alley around St. Mark’s and turn RIGHT on Delannoy and RIGHT on Harrison to finish.
- All post-race activities will be in Riverfront Park and adjacent field.
- Medical tent will be located in the field in the northeast corner
- Ambulance access will be via Riveredge Blvd. (opposite the command post)
- Bus route remains the same (new contractor)
