Finance

- A balanced budget has been complied. Presenting proposed budget to City Council for approval on 7/23/24. The Cocoa CRA and the Diamond Square CRA financial statements were completed.
- Staff is reconciling costs vs revenue for the Michael C. Blake homes that were recently sold.
- Internal control documentation is being reviewed for FY24 so that the auditors can begin interim audit in August/September.
- Utility billing generated 90,472 utility bills in June 2024.
- Purchasing is working on a cooperative bid for utility chemicals.

Fire Department

- The FireBlast training trailer has been returned to Fire Station 1.
- o Recruit Firefighters graduated from Fire School (EFSC) on May 29th, 2024 and have been added to staffing as full-time employees.
- Multiple Public Relations events attended by crews.
- New Brush truck arrived August 2024 and is currently awaiting modifications at Fleet.
- o Crews worked several special events in downtown Cocoa Village over the last month with several more on the calendar.
