

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-090

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COCOA, FLORIDA, WAIVING THE COMPETITIVE BIDDING PROCESS AND SETTING FORTH THE BASIS OF THE CITY MANAGER’S RECOMMENDATION THEREOF BY EXHIBIT; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF PRIOR INCONSISTENT RESOLUTIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Article XIII of the City Charter of the City of Cocoa and Section 2-4 of the City Code of the City of Cocoa provides that competitive bidding is required for all purchases unless certain requirements are met for exceptions to the bidding requirement; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended that the competitive bidding requirement be waived for the purchase or public improvement described in Exhibit “A” attached to this Resolution and by this reference incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that competitive bidding for the purchase or public improvement described in Exhibit “A” would not be in the City’s best interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COCOA, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The purchase or public improvement described in Exhibit “A” is hereby approved and the competitive bidding requirement is hereby waived. The basis for the City Manager’s recommendation that a competitive bidding procedure would not be in the City’s best interest is attached to this Resolution and by this reference incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 3. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption by the Cocoa City Council.
