## **RESOLUTION NO. 2020-002**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COCOA, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF STATE ROAD RIGHTS-OF-WAY BY CITY; PROVIDING THE FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF PRIOR INCONSISTENT **RESOLUTIONS:** AND **PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.** 

WHEREAS, the City of Cocoa takes pride in attractively maintaining its public roadways, roadsides, and medians; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida will agree to provide monetary compensation to the City of Cocoa if Cocoa will supplement its personnel and equipment resources for the purpose of maintaining state roadways, roadside areas, and medians within the city limits of the City of Cocoa as defined by the Highway Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COCOA, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The Mayor of the City of Cocoa is hereby authorized to enter into a Highway Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement, and mutually agreed upon renewals, with the Florida Department of Transportation.

**SECTION 2.** A copy of this Resolution shall be attached to the Highway Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement as Exhibit "A".

**SECTION 3.** All prior resolutions or prior resolutions inconsistent with this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

**SECTION 4.** If any section, subsection, clause, sentence, or phrase or portion thereof shall, for any reason be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this resolution.

**SECTION 5.** This resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption by the City Council of the City of Cocoa, Florida.
