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
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Findings Summary


The purpose of this report is to provide the City Of Cocoa City Council with an overview of incidents and case reports for October 2019. This report includes a line graph illustrating the total number of UCR Offenses by month for years 2017, 2018 and 2019.

- 3,449 Incidents (Excluding Patrol Checks)
- 369 Case Reports (11% of incidents)
 - 206 Criminal Case Reports (56% of all case reports)
 - 163 Non-Criminal Case Reports (44% of case reports)
 - 66 Criminal Case Reports were closed by Arrests/Capias Requests (32% of criminal case reports)
 - 10 Non-Criminal Case Reports were closed by Arrests/Capias Request (6% of non-criminal cases reports)
- 2,060 Incidents were officer initiated (60%)
- District 1 generated the most cases with a total of 141.
- District 3 experienced the lowest amount of cases generated with a total of 39 cases.
- Aggravated Assault and Aggravated Stalking offenses have <u>decreased</u> by 64% from the previous month.
- Burglary Offenses have <u>decreased</u> by 22% from the previous month.
- Laceny Offenses have *decreased* by 31% from the previous month.
- Overall, UCR offenses have <u>decreased</u> from the previous month by 30%.


Total Patrol Checks and Case Reports for the City of Cocoa








Locations of Incidents




