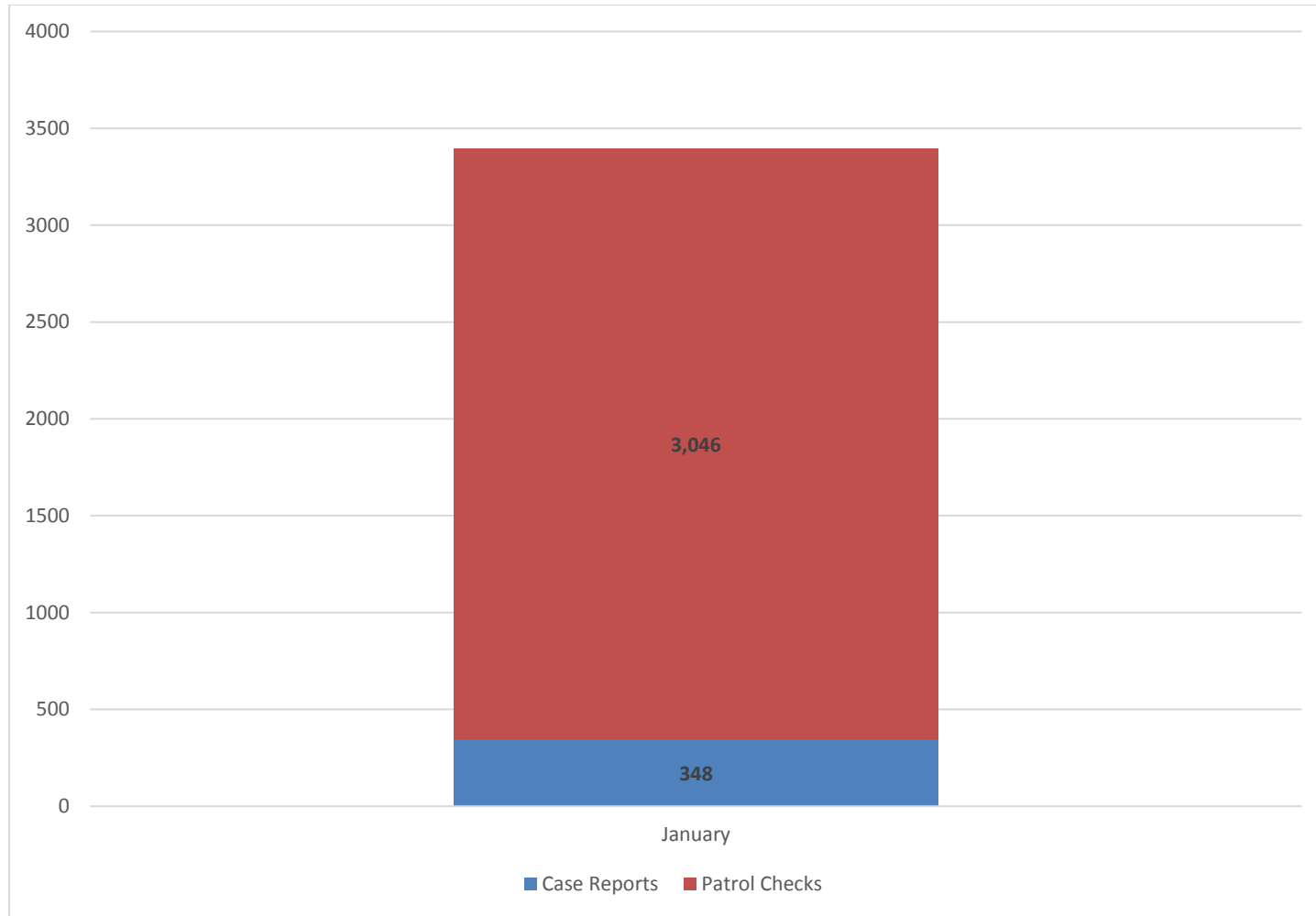

## Findings Summary

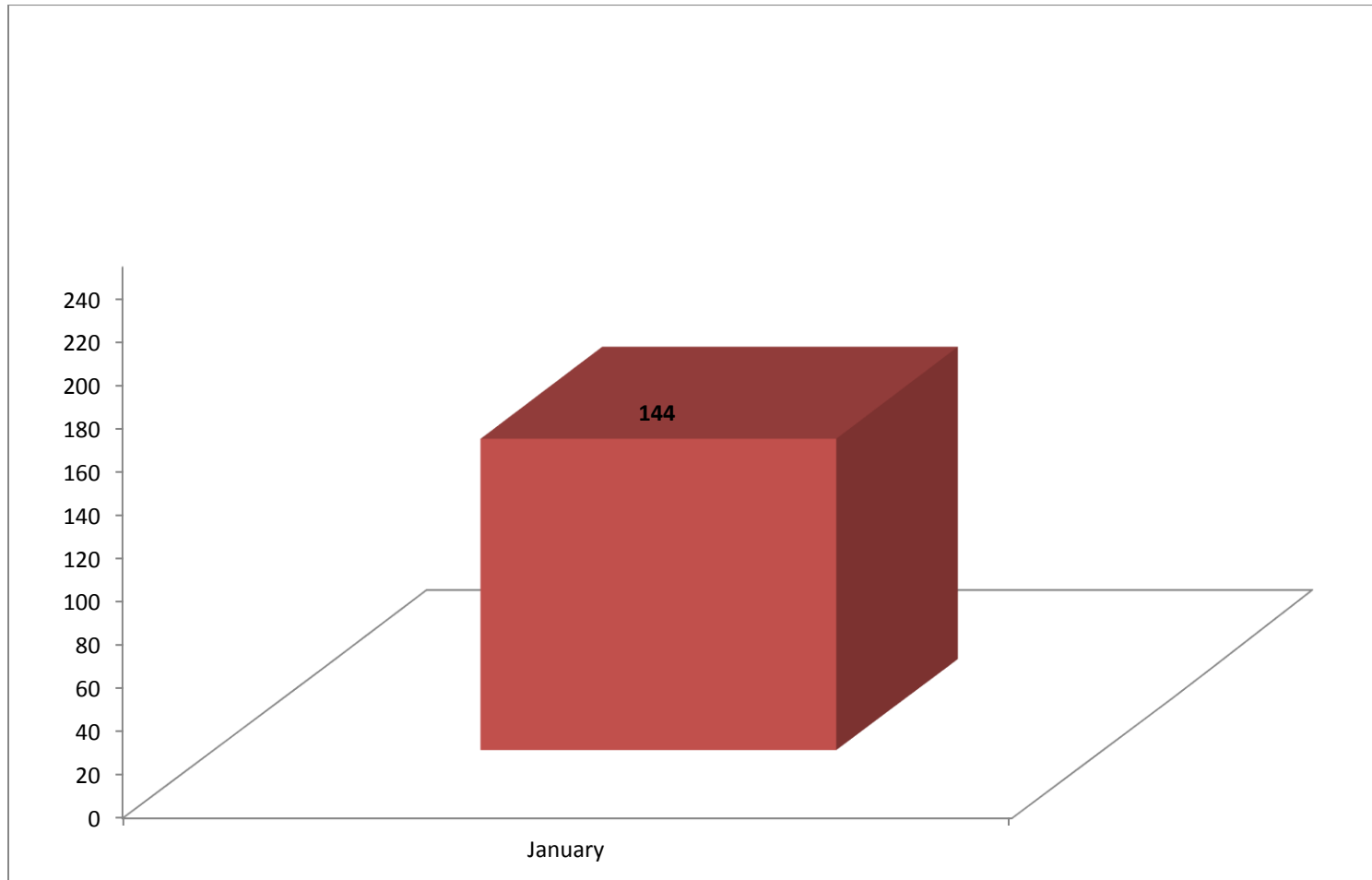
The purpose of this report is to provide Council with an overview of incidents and case reports for January 2020. This report includes a line graph illustrating the total number of UCR Offenses by month for years 2018, 2019 and 2020.

- 3,275 incidents
- 348 Case Reports (11% of incidents)
  - 202 Criminal Case Reports (58% of all case reports)
  - 146 Non-Criminal Case Reports (42% of case reports)
  - 68 Criminal Case Reports were closed by Arrests/Capias Requests (34% of criminal case reports)
  - 47 Non-Criminal Case Reports were closed by Arrests/Capias Request (32% of non-criminal cases reports)
- 3,506 incidents were initiated by police officers
- District 1 experienced the most cases with a total of 144
- District 3 experienced the fewest cases with a total of 33
- Larceny Offenses have **increased** by a 12% from the previous month
- Burglary Offenses have **decreased** by a 71% from the previous month
- Robbery Offences have **decreased** by 29% from the previous month
- Overall, UCR offenses have **decreased** from the previous month by an 20%

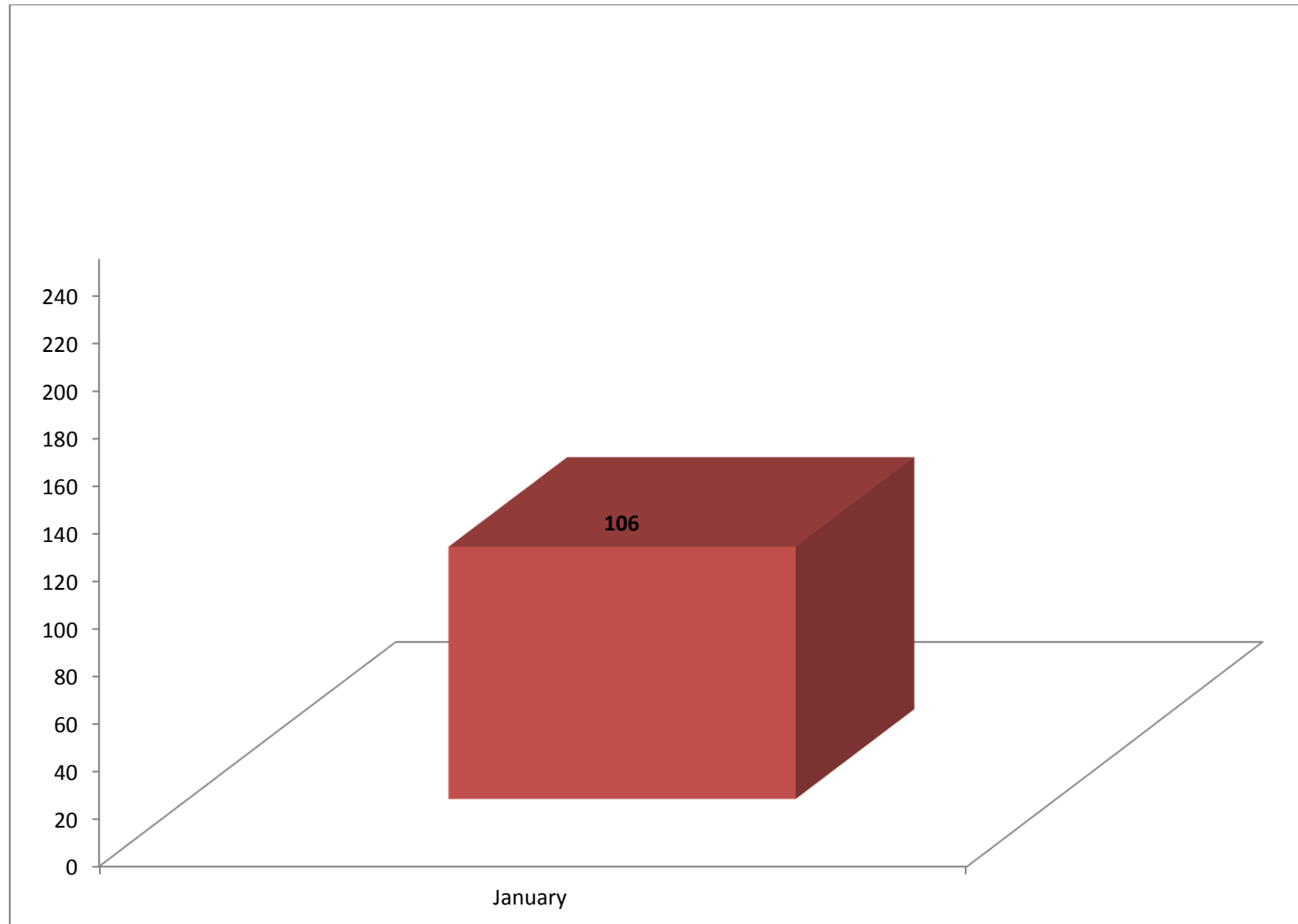

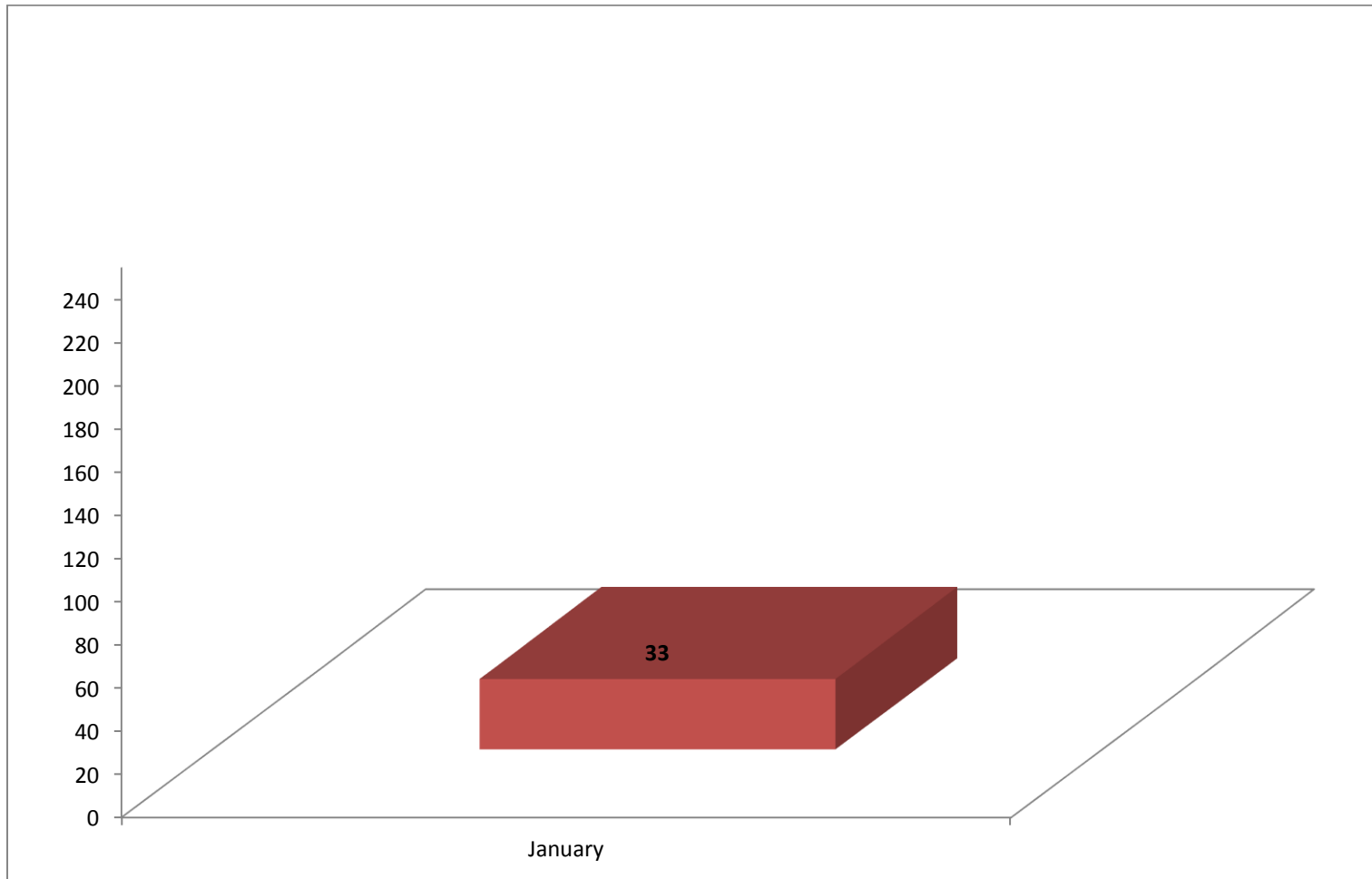

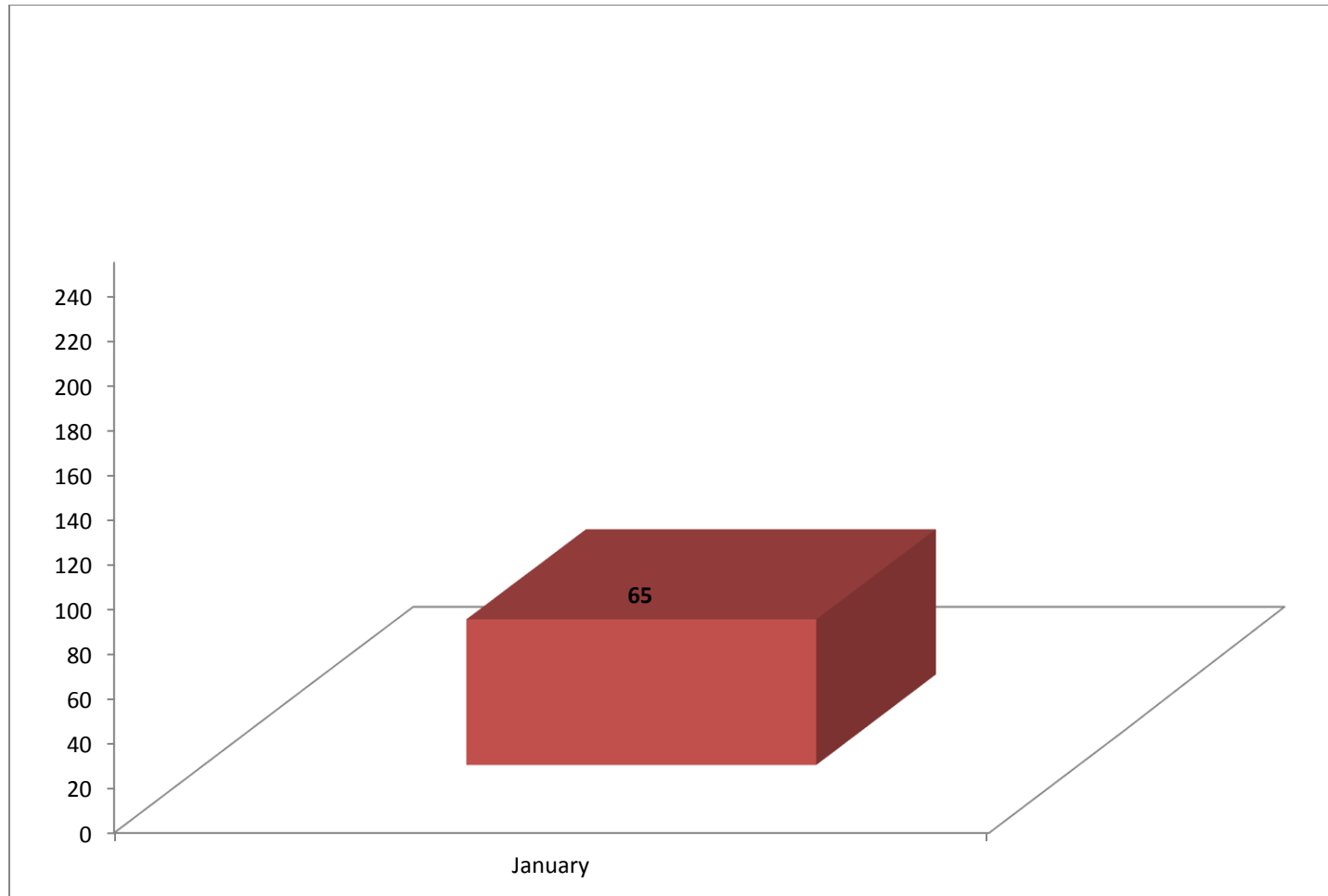

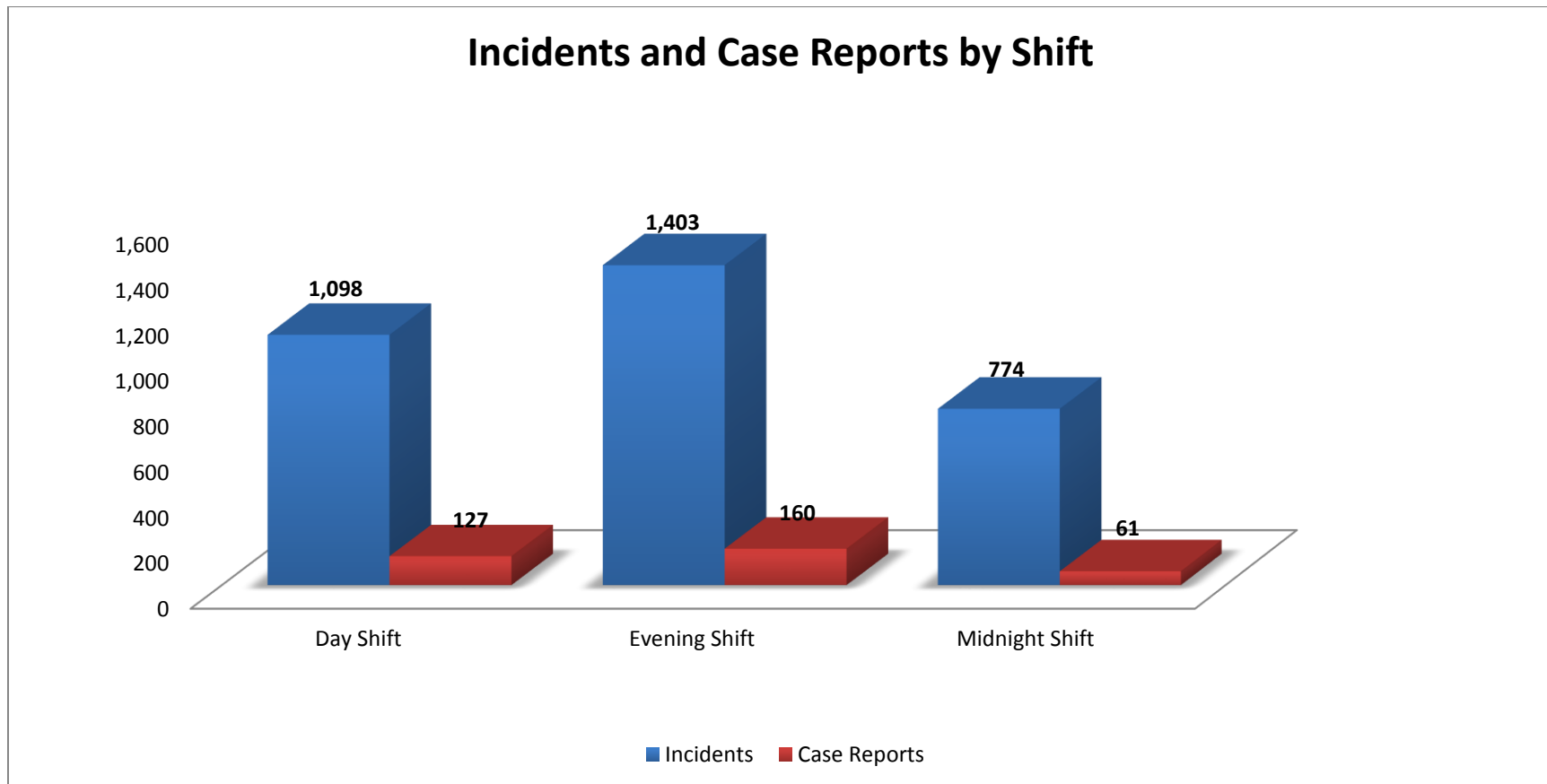
## Locations of Incidents

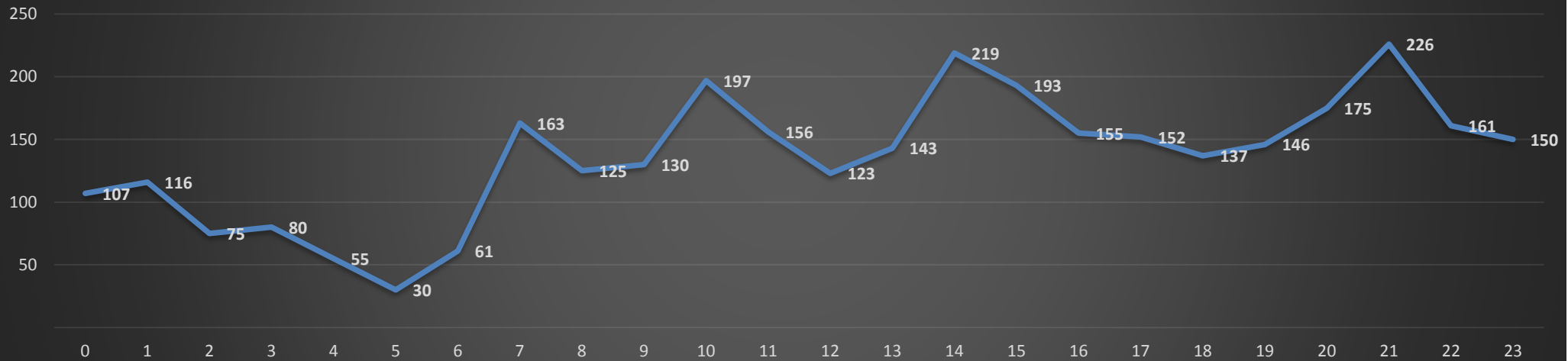

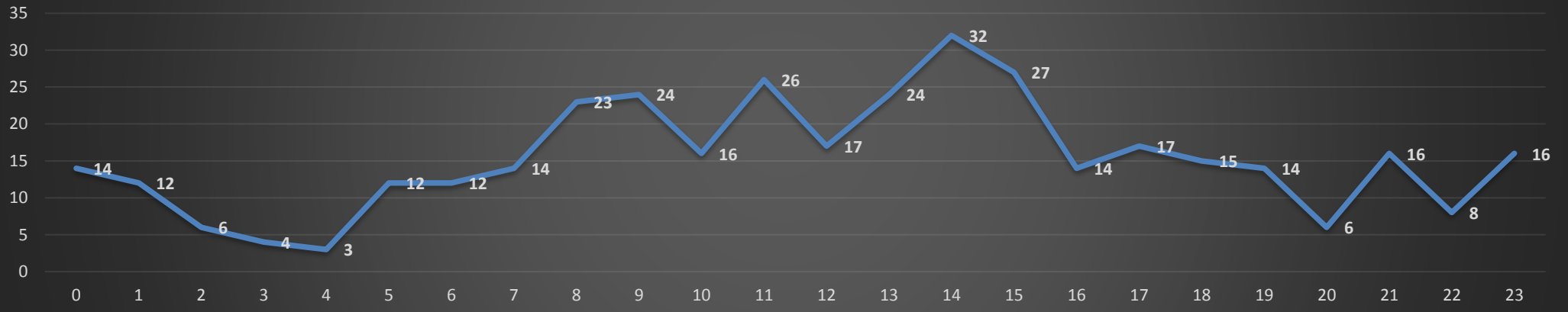

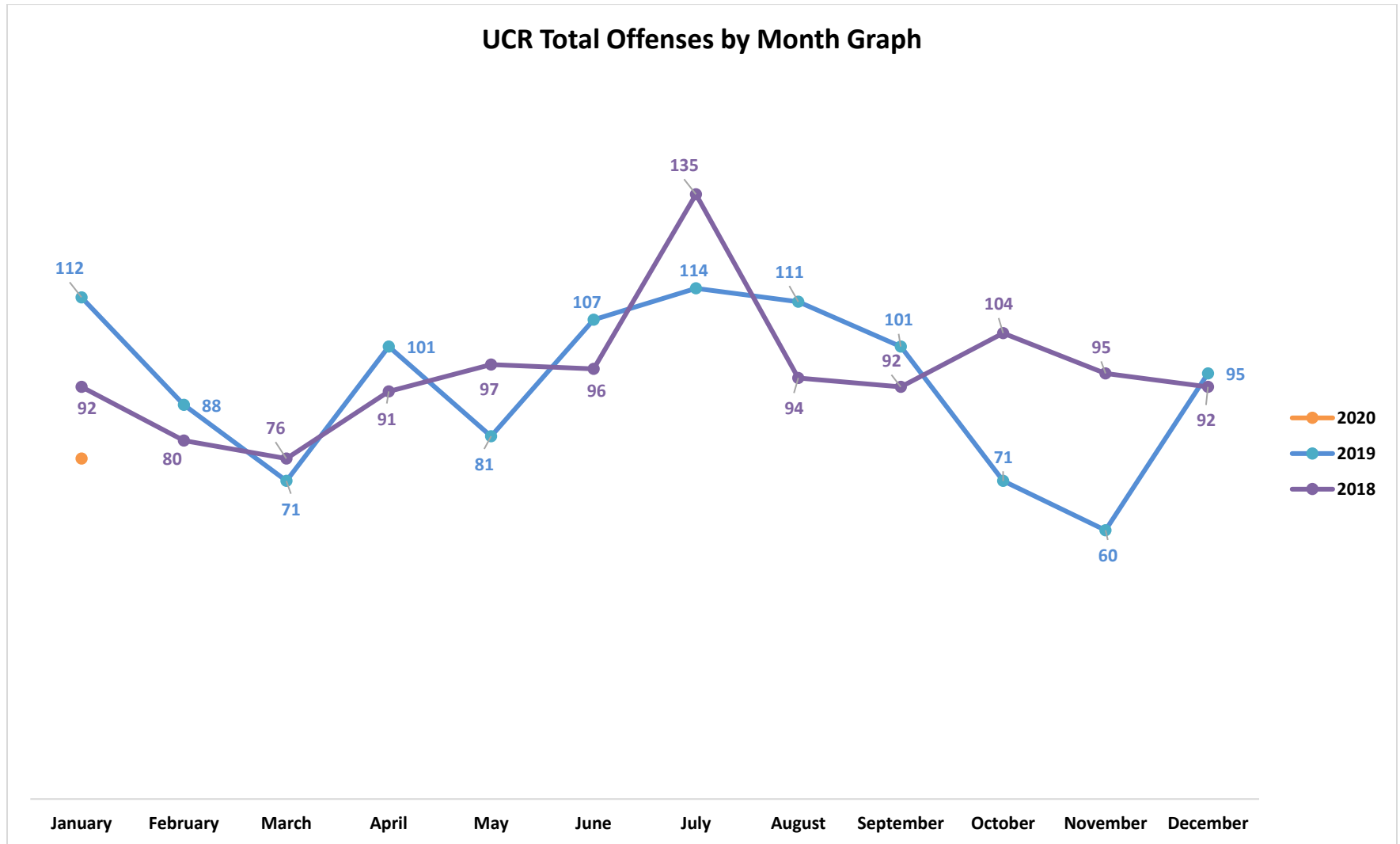
### January Incidents by Hour Totals
