The City of Cocoa will be adding an Emergency Management component to our fall Citizens Academy that will educate our residents on the importance of preparedness during an emergency. The additional component to our Citizens Academy program will offer an insight in to preparing and working a disaster and prepare our residents and their families as well as their neighbors and friends.

This past fall we held our first ever Citizens Academy, which was a huge success in that it helped engage some of our citizens in their local government. It gave them insight into each of our city departments and their local government officials. Participants in the first ever program were able to tour facilities and get a hands on, behind the scenes tour of the City of Cocoa. The feedback received from our participants was outstanding.

With the onset of the recent COVID-19 pandemic and the current hurricane season, it became clear that we needed to add an emergency management component to the program. As part of this component of the program we will be providing participants with preparedness kits that will help educate them on the ways they can make sure their families are ready for the next disaster or emergency situation and how they can stay connected to the City for the latest updates and information. By adding this emergency management component to the program, it will help us better prepare our residents and their close contacts for an emergency and show them how the City prepares and responds to emergencies such as the most recent response efforts related to the pandemic.

The program will be a total of 9 sessions and will begin in October. The final session will be slated for March or April 2021, with a graduation ceremony at a City Council meeting.
