RESOLUTION NO. 2021-058

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COCOA, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, REVISING THE BUILDING PERMIT FEE SCHEDULE RELATED TO THE ISSUANCE OF BUILDING PERMITS PURSUANT TO THE FLORIDA BUILDING CODE; REPEALING RESOLUTION 2021-040 IN ITS ENTIRETY; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF PRIOR, INCONSISTENT RESOLUTIONS; SEVERABILITY; AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

- **WHEREAS,** section 166.222, Florida Statutes, provides that the City Council may establish a schedule of reasonable fees in order to defer the costs of inspection and enforcement of the provisions of the Florida Building Code; and
- **WHEREAS,** the City Council previously adopted Resolution 2021-040, which set forth the City's various fees related to Florida Building Code permitting and processing; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to repeal Resolutions 2021-040 in its entirety and to adopt the updated and revised fee schedule set forth herein; and
- **WHEREAS**, the City Council deems this Resolution to be in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Cocoa.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COCOA, as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** Recitals. The above recitals are hereby deemed true and correct and by this reference are adopted by the City of Cocoa as though fully set forth herein.
- **SECTION 2.** <u>Adoption of Fee Schedule.</u> Pursuant to its authority set forth in section 166.222, Florida Statutes, the City Council of the City of Cocoa hereby adopts the fee schedule set forth in **Exhibit "A,"** attached hereto and fully incorporated herein by this reference.
- **SECTION 3.** Repeal of Prior Inconsistent Resolutions. City of Cocoa Resolution 2021-040 is hereby repealed in its entirety, and any other prior resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.
- **SECTION 4.** Severability. If any section, clause, phrase, word, or provision is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, whether for

substantive or procedural reasons, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution.

SECTION 5. <u>Effective Date.</u> This resolution shall become effective **July 13, 2021** upon adoption by the City Council of the City of Cocoa.
