**Requested Action:**

Accept the Brevard County Lucas Chest Compression Grant Revenues and Approve a Resolution Amending the FY2020 Budget, BAF#20-041-A.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Fire Department applied for a Brevard County EMS Grant in late 2019 for a Lucas Compression Device. The Lucas Device is a piece of medical equipment that assists paramedics and EMTs with chest compressions at medical incidents that require CPR. On January 28<sup>th</sup>, 2019 the City was notified that it had been awarded the EMS grant for the Lucas Device in the amount of \$16,541.00. This is a 100% grant and there is no required match by the City.
